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Reading Guide Examples

How to use reading guides. The teacher determines the major ideas from a book or an assigned reading and considers each student's knowledge related to the concepts. Teachers then write questions or statements designed to guide readers through the major ideas and supporting details of the text. Guides may be phrased as statements or as questions.

Background. Reading Guides help students navigate reading material, especially difficult textbook chapters or technical reading. Students respond to a teacher-created written guide of prompts as they read an assigned text. Reading Guides help students to comprehend the main points of the reading and understand the organizational structure of a text.

Each subject is different, and requires a slightly different study method. In math, for example, you might want to include formulas and sample problems on your study guide. Test yourself on sample problems by trying to do them without looking at the solution. For English you might have read novels, so you'll want to include information about plot and characters on your study guide.

A Three-Level Reading Guide is a printed form students use to analyze a text selection. This guide allows students to record their reading comprehension at three levels: Literal Level–Understanding the literal meaning of the words and ideas in a reading selection.

Steps for Creating a Three-Level Reading Guide:

What it is: Leveled reading is a way to comprehend, interpret and apply difficult texts by working at the literal, interpretive and applied levels. What it does: Leveled reading helps readers to go beyond the surface of a text in a step-by-step way. Level 1 (literal – reading what is right there) Here the reader finds the answer in the text.
